## What is the Laudato Si'Action Platform?













# Getting to Zero...

- ► Educate, Accompany, Support & SET THE EXAMPLE
- ► Setting the Example 3 areas:
  - 1. Determine where we are: LSAP's initial assessment tool
  - 2. Pursue Net Zero Path/Fossil Fuel Divestment
    - ➤ Net Zero Pathway benchmarking and climate action planning for the future—one option, <a href="https://verdisgroup.com/services/net-zero-pathway/">https://verdisgroup.com/services/net-zero-pathway/</a>
    - > Check on local and state legislation California, for example, requires:
      - ❖ 90% clean energy by 2035, 95% by 2040 (SB 1020)
      - ❖ Net zero carbon emissions by 2045 (AB 1279)
    - > See USCCB Socially Responsible Investment, 2021:
      - "From a Catholic perspective, ethical and socially responsible investing, as the strategy has come to be known, requires us to evaluate specific investments in terms of how those companies or entities protect life, promote human dignity, act justly, enhance the common good, and provide care for the environment."
      - "...socially responsible investing is a holistic framework that sees economic development intrinsically linked to integral human development and good stewardship of God's creation."





# Southern Building






System Size kW <sub>DC</sub>	19.7 kW

Energy Offset	27.3 %

Estimated Cost	\$143,766
Payback Period	18.6 Years
Carbon Offset	20 MTCO <sub>2</sub> e

# A Higher Calling





Response to the Cry of the Earth: greater use of clean renewable energy and reducing fossil fuels in order to achieve carbon neutrality, efforts to protect and promote biodiversity, guaranteeing access to clean water for all, etc.

## **Decarbonization Process**

1

#### **MEASURE (See)**

Complete a greenhouse gas inventory to account for all emissions emitted by your organization.

#### **TARGET (Judge)**

Understand the levers that you have to reduce your emissions and decide what is the best climate goal and timeline for your organization.

#### **IMPLEMENT (Act)**

3

Organize the implementation of the selected strategies and track the progress towards your goals.





## 2021 EMISSIONS MtCO<sub>2</sub>e




- In 2021, Diocese of Davenport emitted 134 metric tons of CO<sub>2</sub> equivalent
- Equivalent to:
  - o 16.9 homes energy for a year
  - 28.9 cars driven for a year






