



I acclaim you as the divine milieu, charged with creative power, as the ocean stirred by the Spirit, as the clay moulded and infused with life by the incarnate Word....


Raise me up then, matter, to those heights, through struggle and separation and death; raise me up until, at long last, it becomes possible for me in perfect chastity to embrace the universe.




Creative Union: new and more complex forms of matter come about by a process of union.






When two or more entities cede their sense of individualism but not their identity and unite, they become capable of more, of something new.





Nuclei to Atoms






Atoms to Molecules






Complexity/Consciousness


As Matter complexifies, it becomes capable of generating and sustaining more developed forms of consciousness.


As Matter becomes more conscious, it encourages greater complexity.




Teilhardian Principles:

- Looking with hope and confidence to the future






The flame must be revived at all costs. At all costs, we must renew in ourselves the desire and the hope for the great Coming.
